February is upon us! It may be winter, but you can warm your hearts by joining us for the VALENTINE-MAKING PARTY on Saturday, Feb. 3 from 2-4:00 PM. Then you can also warm the hearts of others by sending those and other Valentines to folks who might need a little pick-me-up – including our home-bound parishioners. Afterward - around 4 PM - we will have the "Burning of the Palms" outside - burning last year's palms from Palm Sunday - to produce our Ashes for Ash Wednesday - with help from our young folks.

Then get ready to enjoy another community celebration at the Mardi Gras Pancake Supper on Shrove Tuesday February 13 (the day before Ash Wednesday) from 5:30 – 7:30. Come for pancakes and sausage and a special cake – wear fun hats and beads and be a little silly!

Our Ash Wednesday liturgies on February 14 will be at noon and 6 PM. I will also be offering Ashes to Go – on our corner at Washington and Maple – from 3-4PM.

As we move into Lent in the middle of the month, I urge you not to think of what you might give up – but instead what practice you might take up during this season. 

Minutes for 2023 Annual Meeting

St. John's Annual Meeting Minutes, January 21st, 2024. Recorded by Adam Baker.

Vestry conducted opening prayer.

Kevin Davidson nominated, Nancy Herman-Kinney seconded. Adam was elected Clerk for the meeting.

Dan Eichinger moved that we accept the minutes from the 2023 meeting, Nancy seconded. Congregation approved.

Olivia Ohler moved we accept the agenda for the meeting, Nancy Herman-Kinney seconded. Congregation accepted.

Diane moved on to election of Vestry. Olivia and Nancy's terms are ending and they were not seeking re-election.

Nancy reported that Liz Brockman was open to serving on Vestry. Liz and Clancy DeLong were nominated to election to Vestry as well as Gerald May, who is up for re-election. Ford Dingman moved we elect all those nominated, Harriett White seconded. We elected all candidates.

Diane moved on to delegates to Diocesan convention. Diane and Sam Raisanen nominated Nancy Herman-Kinney and Alice Ciccu to be delegates to Diocesan Convention. Ford Dingman moved candidates be elected, Liz seconded. Christi Brookes and Clancy DeLong were nominated as alternates to the diocesan convention. Olivia Ohler moved that Christi and Clancy be elected as alternates, Pat Thurston seconded. We elected them.

Diane discussed the statistical report that David Shirley submitted. She reported that Sunday attendance is slowly on its way back up. Diane expressed thanks to David for compiling that report.

Dan Eichinger moved an amendment for the income side of the budget to include a line item for special appeal to resolve any deficit arising from fully funding the previous motion. Jillian seconded. Motion carried. Congregation expressed thanks for Clancy's work in preparing the budget.


